- © Do not install this equipment at the place which can be wetted by rain and and be sunk by water.

◎ Do not wash & clean while the motor Box Cover is opened.

How to use (Usage)



1. Water Supply / Drain

- 1 Exchange the water in The Water Tank at every 1-5 days according to its dirty grade (or condition).
- 2 Open the Drain Valve, drain the water in the Water Tank, and close the Drain Valve again. Then, open the Water Supply Valve and fill the water until the below blue dotted line.

- In case of overflow of the blue dotted lines, open the Overflow Lid and release the water.

2. Detergent (Option)



3. Replace of Brush







4. Absorbent Mat

It should be always wetted enough for the use. Be careful not to dry The Sponge Mat.



5. Set the Timer



- Turn on The Main Switch on The Control Box. Then, Green light is on The Lamp.
- 2 Turn on The Timer Setting Switch. (ON)
- 3 Press The Timer Setting Button.
 - (from min. 5sec to Max. 15sec)
- 4 Turn off The Timer Setting Switch definitely after setting time. (OFF)

(* After stopping operation, it takes

approximately 2 sec. to re-start operation.)

Installation

1 Take out the equipment from the packing carton. After standing The Safety Bar, fix it with two hexagon volts per each side. In case of DX Types, 4 hexagon volts.







Insert the Water Supply Pipe for Outside
into the One-Touch Cap directly.
In case of seperate Water Supply Pipe from the Tap,
pull out the Pipe (or, Hose) pressing the Tap
